The job duties/responsibilities are listed as follows;

- 2) To be able - available to work independently for up to 15-20 hours per month at the hourly rate of \$25 at either the club office at EADCC or your home office starting to work on September 1st.
- 3) To oversee the Club's Games/Program - Schedule plan, chiefly 3 Thursdays/some Saturday/Sunday monthly including some helping hands/mind w/ CDSC & SADC and Host Committee Executives for 5th AD55+GC in Calgary and its future 2028+ Games.
- 4) To oversee the annual Club Calendar project w/ schedule plans working closely w/ CDSC, SADC and some new - future groups in Red Deer and other places in Alberta.
